

Donna Echiverri-Beckham was born and raised in Manila, Phillipine Islands. She obtained her law degree and first bar license in the Philippines. Donna first worked briefly as an elementary grade and sports teacher in Muslim Mindanao. She then worked as an economic and financial analyst in the late 1970s until she was invited to work in the Office of the Philippine President in 1978.
