Arati Vasan (she/her) is a Senior Managing Attorney at Family Violence Appellate Project ("FVAP"). She represents survivors of gender-based and family violence on appeal and manages FVAP's training and law clerk/fellow programs. Arati provided full-scope family/civil court representation for survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking in the Bay Area for a decade before joining FVAP in 2018. Arati has given trainings for a wide range of stakeholders at the local, state and national level. She is on the facilitator faculty for the ABA Commission on Domestic and Sexual Violence and has been a faculty trainer for Practising Law Institute and the Vera Institute on Justice. Arati received her qualification as a California Domestic Violence Counselor in 2009 from Asian Women's Shelter. Prior to FVAP, Arati was a staff attorney and coordinated the domestic violence program work at Asian Pacific Islander Legal Outreach. Earlier she had a solo family law practice representing survivors of domestic violence. Arati was a pro bono volunteer for Bay Area Legal Aid and is a past recipient of their Individual Pro Bono Leadership Award. Arati has been licensed to practice law in California since 2008.
